# Introduction:

True servanthood heals, while an attitude of lordship tears and wounds. Many people try to minister out of emptiness and darkness, rather than fullness and light.

**Text:** 1 Peter 5:1-7

**To the elders among you, I appeal as a fellow elder, a witness of Christ's sufferings and one who also will share in the glory to be revealed:**

**Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, serving as overseers—not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not greedy for money, but eager to serve; not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock.**

True servanthood understands that roles and positions within the Body of Christ must be:

Acknowledged as  
**CONDITIONAL** and  
**TEMPORARY**, not  
**ABSOLUTE** and  
**PERMANENT.**

True servanthood is a spirit.

It can't be:

**MANDATED** in a job

description.

**MEASURED** in a performance

review.

**MANUFACTURED** in a training

seminar.

True servanthood focuses on:

Maximizing **OPPORTUNITIES**,  
not meeting minimum  
**OBLIGATIONS**.

The **WELFARE** of those being  
served, not the **PRIVILEGES** of  
those who wield authority.

True servanthood requires a spirit of:

**CARING.**

**HUMILITY.**

**SUBMISSION.**

True servanthood results in a  
constant **EMPTYING** of ego and  
self.

Being continually filled by God's Holy Spirit will experience constant spiritual and personal **RENEWAL**.

Not being continually filled by God's Holy Spirit will experience spiritual **BANKRUPTCY** and personal **COLLAPSE**.
