# Have **Introduction:**

# YOU

When we receive Jesus, we receive a person who is both fully divine and fully human.

# JESUS ?

**Text: Hebrews 2:1-18**

**We must pay more careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away.**

**For if the message spoken by angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment, how shall we escape if we ignore such a great salvation?**

**This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him.**

**God also testified to it by signs, wonders and various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.**

**It is not to angels that he has subjected the world to come, about which we are speaking.**

**But there is a place where someone has testified: "What is man that you are mindful of him, the son of man that you care for him? You made him a little lower than the angels; you crowned him with glory and honor and put everything under his feet."**

**In putting everything under him, God left nothing that is not subject to him.**

**Yet at present we do not see everything subject to him.**

**But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, now crowned with glory and honor because he suffered death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.**

**In bringing many sons to glory, it was fitting that God, for whom and through whom everything exists, should make the author of their salvation perfect through suffering.**

**Both the one who makes men holy and those who are made holy are of the same family. So Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers.**

**He says,**

**“I will declare your name to my brothers;  
in the presence of the congregation I will  
sing your praises.”**

**And again, “I will put my trust in him.”**

**And again he says, “Here am I, and the  
children God has given me.”**

**Have you  
RECEIVED  
JESUS?**

**Since the children have flesh and blood,  
he too shared in their humanity so that by  
his death he might destroy him who holds  
the power of death — that is, the devil —  
and free those who all their lives were  
held in slavery by their fear of death.**

**For surely it is not angels he helps, but  
Abraham's descendants.**

**For this reason he had to be made like his brothers in every way, in order that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in service to God, and that he might make atonement for the sins of the people.**

**Because he himself suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.**

Hebrews 2:1-18

God accepts us as His children, and has a plan to

**ELEVATE** us into **ROYALTY**

through a difficult but effective process!
