PEOPLE ARE WITHOUT EXCUSE.**


**ROMANS**

The **WRATH** of God is not a mere emotion of sudden anger, but is a deliberate, purposeful **ACCUMULATION** of **JUDGEMENT.**




*Since blindness is the prevailing state of our culture, we will never receive deliverance and healing from it!*


