
**Like the caterpillar that crawls the Earth,


Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.



Sometimes it helps to start at the beginning. After Jesus rose from the dead:


WHAT did He do?

requires:


FAITH

TRUST


(Everything God does and allows in my life is for the ultimate purpose of blessing me, and blessing others).



requires:


The **LOVE** and
