WISHFUL thinking —

“Things ought to be different.”

UNBELIEF — “Prove it to me.”

Robbing our spirits of **HOPE**.

Wrecking our **FUTURES**.

Regret is wasteful of our time
and worthless in improving
our lives!

IGNORE our regrets, but that we

TRANSFORM them into

REPENTANCE.
