Text: Romans 1:18-21

**The wrath of God is being revealed
from heaven against all the**

**godlessness and wickedness of
people, who suppress the truth by
their wickedness, since what may be
known about God is plain to them,
because God has made it plain to
them.**

ROMANS

**For since the creation of the world
God's invisible qualities — his eternal
power and divine nature — have
been clearly seen, being understood
from what has been made, so that
PEOPLE ARE WITHOUT EXCUSE.**

ROMANS

**For although they knew God, they
neither glorified him as God nor gave
thanks to him, but their thinking
became futile and their foolish hearts
were darkened.**

Romans 1:18-21

The **WRATH** of God is not a mere emotion of sudden anger, but is a deliberate, purposeful **ACCUMULATION** of **JUDGEMENT.**


Since blindness is the prevailing state of our culture, we will never receive deliverance and healing from it!
