### **Introduction:**

Sonny Liston and George Foreman lost to Muhammad Ali, Mike Tyson lost to Buster Douglas, and a giant named Goliath lost to a shepherd boy with a sling. Makes you think, doesn't it?

### **David understood that:**

**Goliath wasn't the real enemy. He was just Satan's \_\_\_\_\_

*Satan often tries to create a Reality Distortion Field around us.  
Deception is his most effective weapon!*

### **Faith allowed David to:**
