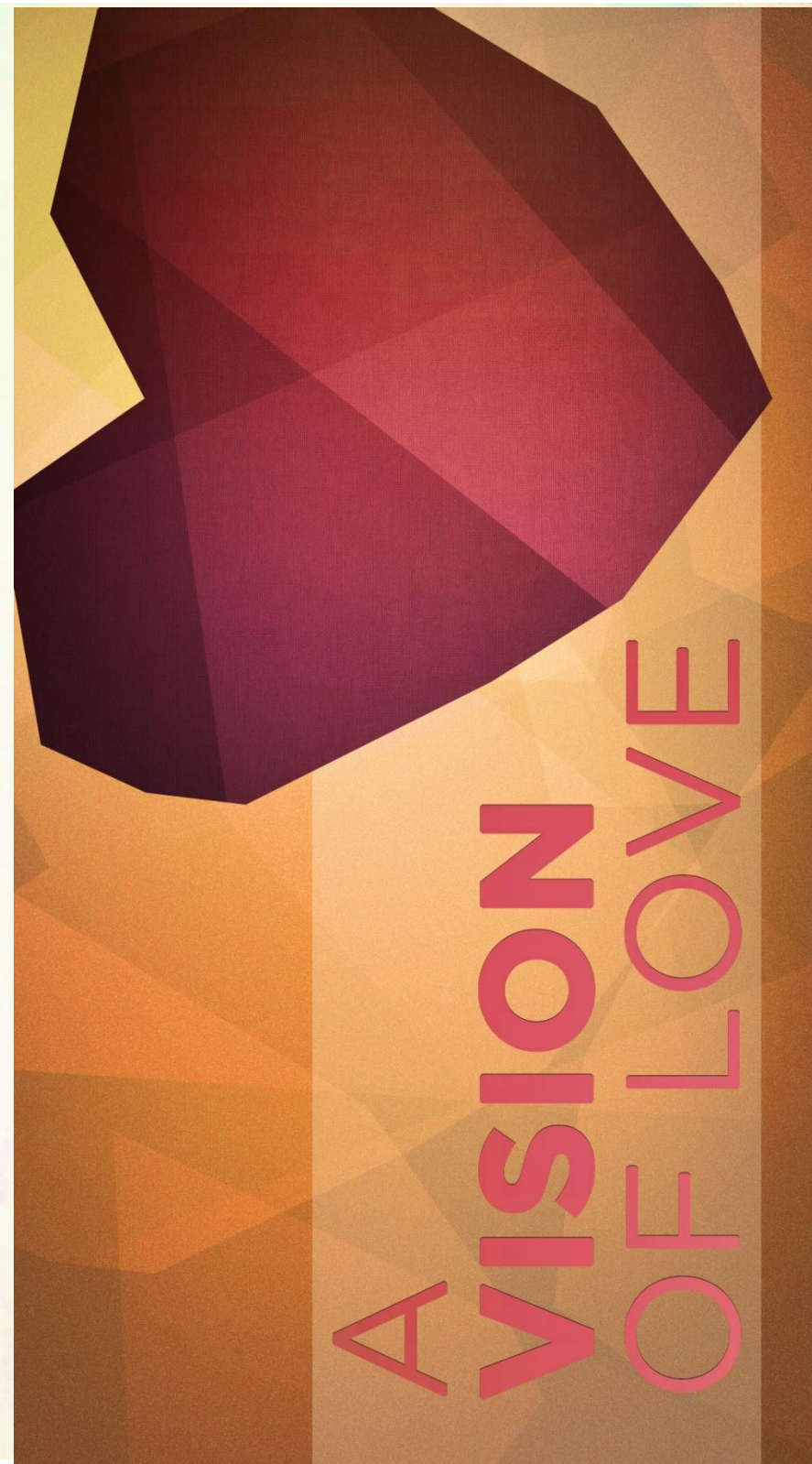

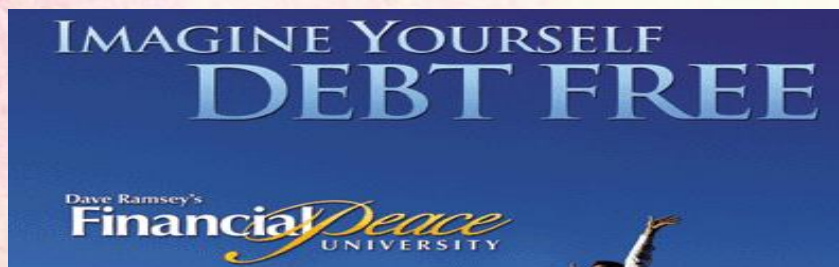
Classes, Bible Studies & more
